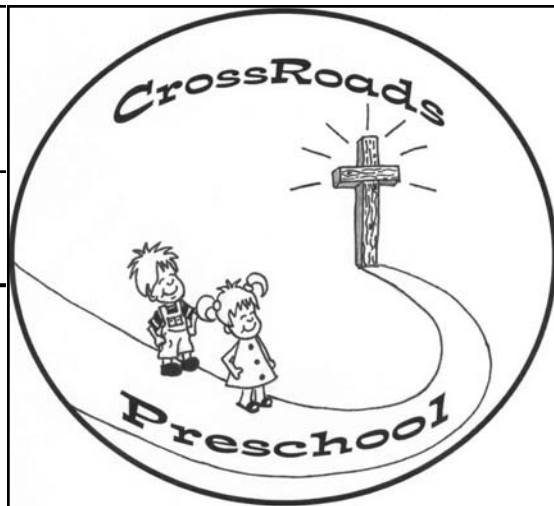

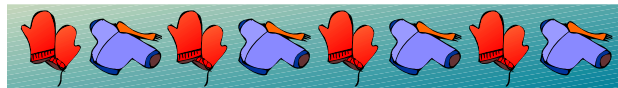
The children's choir of Hebron Baptist Church
