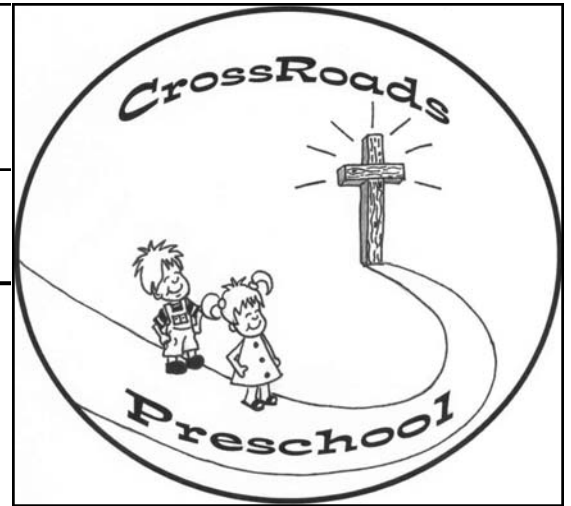

Watch for your child’s letter bag to come home and help fill it with an object !!

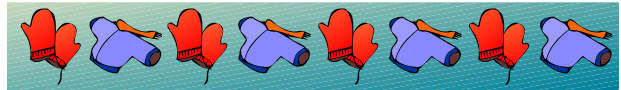
Spanish Class
