Jan. 26th—"O" week

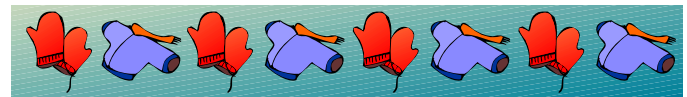
Watch for their letter bag to come home and help them fill it with an object !!
