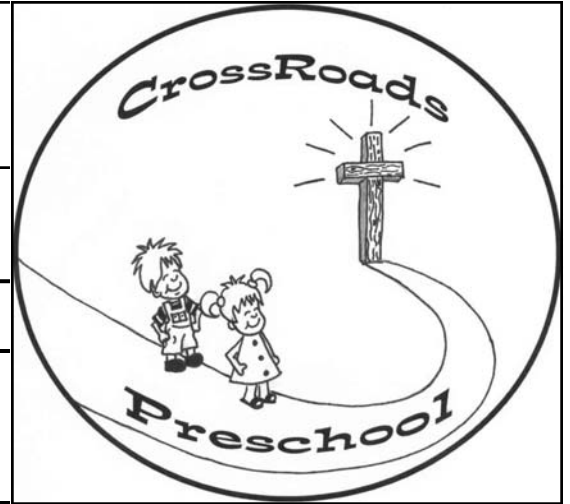

May's Bible Theme

They will cover topics such as families, homes, our bodies, neighborhoods and communities.
