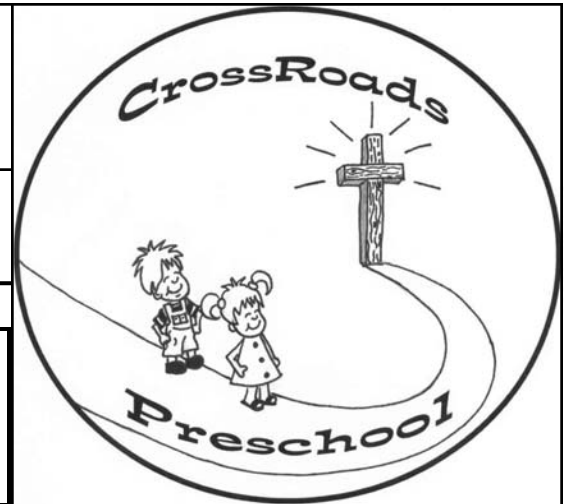

Oct. 26th—“F” week

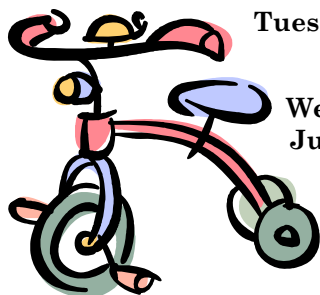
Watch for their letter bag to come home and help them fill it with an object !!
