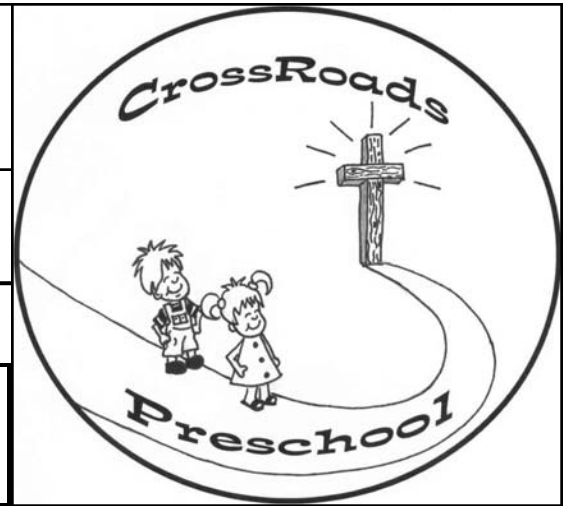

The four year olds will begin the “Letter of the Week” on Sept. 15.

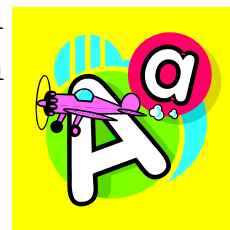
Sept. 15th—”A” week
