

on Wednesday, February 19, 2025 is for you!

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- All current CrossRoads families are eligible to participate in Priority Registration.
- You can register this year's 3 year old student for a 4 year old class or register a younger sibling for a 3 or 4 year old class.
- If you are considering an additional year at CrossRoads for your current Pre-K student, please let Miss Terri know before Priority Registration day so we can discuss class options.
- Fill out the registration form which will be sent by email. Forms will also be available on our website and on the entry table. Mark your first and second choice of classes in case one fills up.
- Place completed registration form along with the \$50 fee in a **sealed envelope** with your child's name on the outside
- I will begin collecting envelopes at the main preschool doors at 8:30 am on Wednesday, February 19 and I will number them in the order they are received. I will remain at the doors until about 9:15. If you arrive later to drop off your form, please ring the bell. I will also be available to collect forms during morning pick up and afternoon drop off times.
- You will receive an email receipt for your registration fee and a confirmation of your class enrollment later in the day.
- Classes are filled on a first come, first served basis. I cannot number any registrations prior to the morning of 2/19 to be sure it's fair for everyone. Please contact Miss Terri if you have any questions!



KINDERGARTEN READINESS CONFERENCES:

In February, you will receive a written progress report for your Pre-K student. We will also offer Kindergarten-Readiness Conferences on Friday 2/14 for any parent who would like an in-person meeting with the teacher to go over the report. Speak to your teacher about scheduling a conference time. Conferences will be about 15 minutes in length to discuss your child's progress as well as our recommendations regarding Kindergarten readiness. In order to make the meetings productive, your child may not be present during the conference. If you are unable to arrange for child-care, please speak with your teacher about scheduling a conference during school hours or by phone.

3 Year Old Assessments:

We do not hold Kindergarten-Readiness conferences for students in our 3 year old classes. You will also receive a written assessment in February. After you review the report, if you have concerns and would like to meet with Miss Cindy, please let us know so we can set up a time.
