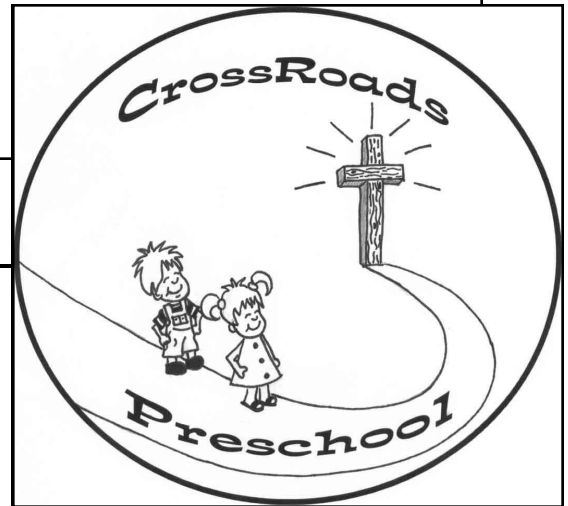

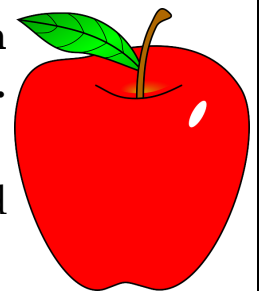
Beginning the week of September 16th we will start focusing on a different letter each week, going through the entire alphabet as the year progresses.

Vision Screenings



The Lions Club is coming to CrossRoads again this year on September 24 and 25 to perform free, non-invasive vision screenings for our preschoolers. They simply take a picture of your child's eyes (then give them a sticker.) Each year, with the technology available through the Lions Club, we are able to identify a few children who need further testing by an eye doctor. We are so appreciative of their efforts to catch and correct vision problems at an early age.
